

Mosaics

For the book 'The Story of Philemon and Baucis' we decided to look at one of the many Roman art forms, mosaics.

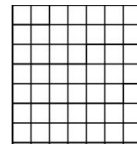
You will need:

- A small piece of square cardboard
- Small coloured square cardboard pieces to be used as tiles
- Glue- brushes, pots
- Pencil



What you do:

1. Draw a grid on your piece of card- seven squares across, seven squares down.
2. Shade in the letter on the piece of card.
3. Stick the small coloured cards on top of the shaded squares - make sure this is all one colour.



4. Fill in the background with various coloured card (for good results use a lighter colour for the background and a darker colour for the letter).
5. When satisfied with the design, stick all the remaining pieces of coloured card onto the grid.
